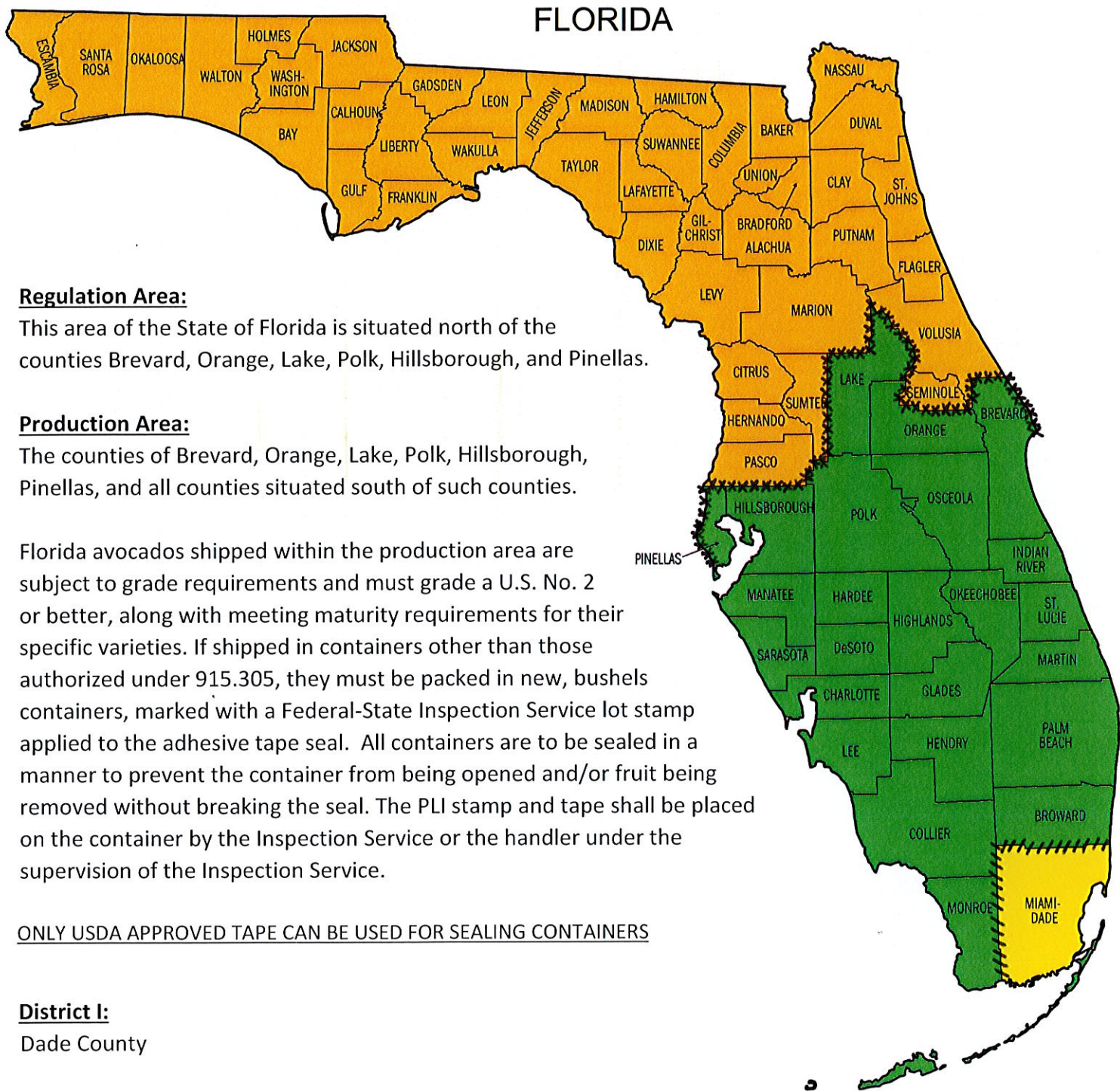


AREAS & DISTRICTS – AVOCADOS



Regulation Area:

This area of the State of Florida is situated north of the counties Brevard, Orange, Lake, Polk, Hillsborough, and Pinellas.

Production Area:

The counties of Brevard, Orange, Lake, Polk, Hillsborough, Pinellas, and all counties situated south of such counties.

Florida avocados shipped within the production area are subject to grade requirements and must grade a U.S. No. 2 or better, along with meeting maturity requirements for their specific varieties. If shipped in containers other than those authorized under 915.305, they must be packed in new, bushels containers, marked with a Federal-State Inspection Service lot stamp applied to the adhesive tape seal. All containers are to be sealed in a manner to prevent the container from being opened and/or fruit being removed without breaking the seal. The PLI stamp and tape shall be placed on the container by the Inspection Service or the handler under the supervision of the Inspection Service.

ONLY USDA APPROVED TAPE CAN BE USED FOR SEALING CONTAINERS
